

Sedation / Twilight anaesthesia

When you arrive for surgery, an intravenous cannula will be placed in your arm; you will be put to sleep this way for a brief period while your eye region is anaesthetised with local anesthetic.

You will feel in a "twilight" state as you will be relaxed and comfortable but may respond to instructions. You will be given medication to make you sleepy and may be given medication to completely forget the procedure.
