Anaesthetics

- sedation

Sedation / Twilight anaesthesia

When you arrive for surgery, an intravenous cannula will be placed in your arm; you will be put to sleep this way for a brief period while your eye region is anaesthetised with local anesthetic.

You will feel in a “twilight” state as you will be relaxed and comfortable but may respond to instructions. You will be given medication to make you sleepy and may be given medication to completely forget the procedure.

How long is the stay in daysurgery / operation?

1 - 2 hours

What to expect post-op

- bruising
- stitches
- tubes
- pad

Complications / Risks

- bleeding
- infection
- other

Follow up

Mostly at:

- 1 week
- 6 weeks

Fasting for surgery

To be confirmed by the Nurse the Tuesday one week prior to your Surgery day.

Documents to read, complete and sign

You will receive by post or email the following documents:

- Informed Financial Consent (Quote) (to be signed by patient)
- GP Letter (to be completed by GP)
- Medical History Form (to be completed)
- Privacy Consent (to be signed)
- Pre-admission Pamphlet
- Procedure Information Pamphlet
- Drug and Medical Information Sheet

Signed/Completed documents can also be returned via fax or email.

Carer on Surgery Day

You will be required to have a carer pick you up from our rooms after surgery. They will need to be given the post operative instructions with you by the nurse. You do not need to have a carer drop you off for surgery

Driving

Patients are not advised to drive for at least 24 hours after their procedure.

Post Operative Appointment

This will take place in Dr Ghabrial's consulting rooms one week after surgery

Costing

The full amount is payable upfront and the patient will receive any rebate from their insurer approximately a month after surgery. Revision surgery is at no cost to the patient unless an excess applies, in which case that is the only amount payable by the patient to the hospital.
